Bluebird monitoring is field work observing existing nest box routes in low- and mid-elevation countryside near such locations as Sherwood, Newberg, Dundee, Bald Peak, Scholls, Laurel, Farmington, Wilsonville, Oregon City, Carus, Beaver Creek, Canby, Estacada and other similar areas. We especially encourage volunteers from communities near the bluebird routes.

The route monitor's time commitment is from early April through mid-August, on an assigned nestbox route.
